

Wheels on the Bus

1. Background Knowledge

- 더운 여름, 초원에서 펼쳐지는 동물들의 버스 여행을 담은 이야기입니다. 버스의 구조 (wheels, horn, lights, wipers, door)를 살펴보고 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: (버스 사진을 함께 보며) Look! There is a bus. The bus has many parts. Let's name each part of the bus. There are wheels on the bus.

Child: There is a door on the bus too.

Mom: Great. There are lights and a horn on the bus. What else can you name?

Child: There are wipers on the bus.

Mom: Great. Then do you know who drives the bus?

Child: A bus driver drives the bus.

2. Picture Walking

Mom: Listen. Beep, beep, beep! Here comes a red bus. Who is on the bus?

Child: Animals are on the bus.

Mom: Let's name the animals on the bus. There is Giraffe, Crocodile, Lion, Ostrich, and Kangaroo. Who is the bus driver?

Child: Elephant is the bus driver.

Mom: I wonder where they are going. Let's follow the bus. The title is "Wheels on the Bus". The pictures are by Okkyong Cho.

Mom: There are animals waiting for a bus at the bus stop. Ostrich is hot. Lion and Giraffe are sweating. What do you think?

Child: They look very hot.

Mom: I think so too. Then, "Beep, beep!" The red bus is coming to the bus stop. They must feel very happy to hear the bus beeping.

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Mom: Everybody gets on the bus. The wheels start to move. How do they move?

Mom & Child: The wheels on the bus go round and round, all day long.

Mom: How do the animals feel on the bus?

Child: They look cozy sitting on the bus.

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Mom: The wheels move faster and faster. The bus moves faster too. The bus moves so fast.

Then it goes up and down. What happens to the animals on the bus?

Child: They bounce up and down too.

Mom: That's right. Bags go up and down too.

Mom & Child: The animals on the bus go up and down, all day long.

Mom: But how do they feel?

Child: They must feel scared.

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Mom: Wow! Look! There are many flamingos crossing the road. What might the animals on the bus say?

Child: Watch out! Flamingos!

Mom: Great! The bus is moving. What should the driver do?

Child: The driver should honk the horn.

Mom: Great idea!

Child & Mom: The horn on the bus goes beep beep beep, all day long.

Mom: How do the animals feel on the bus?

Child: They might feel glad that the flamingos are safe.

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Mom: Dark clouds are coming. Look at the bus. What is different?

Child: The lights are on.

Mom: I see. It's dark because of the clouds.

Child & Mom: The lights on the bus go blink blink blink, all day long.

Mom: How do the animals on the bus feel?

Child: They look a little worried because it's dark.

Mom: I hope that they have a safe trip.

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Mom: The dark clouds make rain. What happens to the bus?

Child: The wipers on the bus move.

Child & Mom: The wipers on the bus go swish swish swish, all day long.

Mom: How do the animals feel on the bus?

Child: They look happy because they are on the bus.

Mom: That's right. When it rains, you want to stay inside.

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Mom: Finally the bus stops. Owl and Sheep have some tea. How do the animals on the bus feel?

Child: They want to have tea too.

Mom: Okay, then. Open the door!

Child & Mom: The door on the bus goes open and shut, all day long.

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Mom: Where do they arrive?

Child: They arrive at a swimming pool.

Mom: I see. They took a bus to the swimming pool on this hot day. The driver says, "Now we are here!" How do the animals feel?

Child: They look very excited.

Mom: What would they like to do?

Child: They would like to swim.

Mom: Yes, and they have a great time in the swimming pool.

3. Comprehension Check Up

Mom: Who waits for the bus?

Child: The animals wait for the bus.

Mom: Where are the animals going?

Child: They are going to the swimming pool.

Mom: How is the weather at the bus stop?

Child: It is very hot, but it becomes cloudy.

Mom: So what does the bus driver do?

Child: The bus driver makes the lights go blink blink blink.

Mom: Then what happens?

Child: It rains, so the driver makes the wipers go swish swish swish.

4. Activities

1) 버스의 다양한 움직임과 소리

- 버스 안에서 볼 수 있는 움직임과 들을 수 있는 소리는 무엇이 있는지 함께 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: There are many sounds you can hear from the bus. What sounds can you hear from the bus?

Child: I can hear beep beep.

Mom: What part of the bus makes the beep beep sound?

Child: A horn makes the beep beep sound.

Mom: Great. Now what do the wheels do?

Child: They go round and round.

Mom: Great. The wheels on the bus go round and round. This is a door. What does it do?

Child: It goes open and shut.

Mom: Yes, the door on the bus goes open and shut. Great. (버스 운전사인 척하면서) I'm a bus driver. Get on the bus. Where would you like to go?

Child: I'd like to go to the sea.

Mom: Okay.
