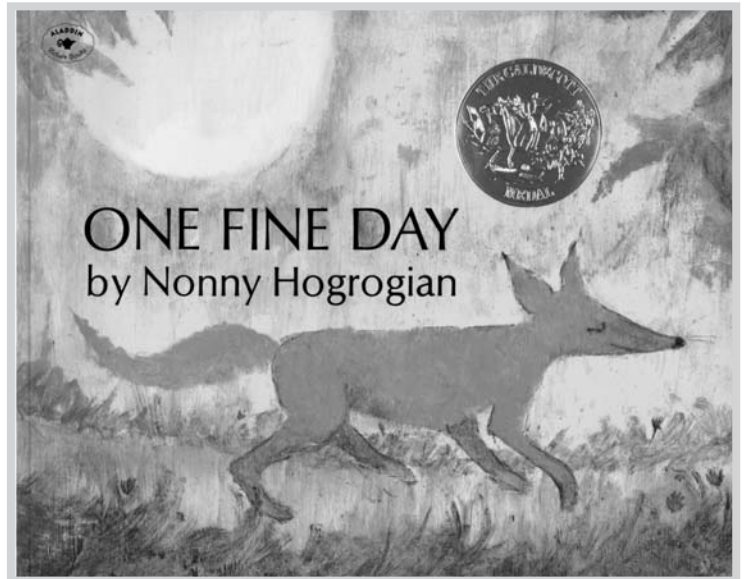

숲 속을 여행하던 여우가 목이 너무 말라 우연히 발견한 우유를 몽땅 다 먹어버립니다. 화가 난 우유 주인 할머니는 여우의 꼬리를 잘라버리고, 꼬리를 다시 찾는 대가로 우유를 구해와야 하는 여우의 고된 여행이 펼쳐집니다.

텍스트가 다소 많지만 반복되는 문장 패턴은 이야기를 쉽게 이해할 수 있게 하며 여우가 만나게 될 다음 인물을 추측하며 읽으면서 아이들의 상상력을 자극할 수 있습니다.

모든 일에는 그에 대한 대가가 따른다는 교훈을 주는 재미있는 이야기를 읽어보세요.

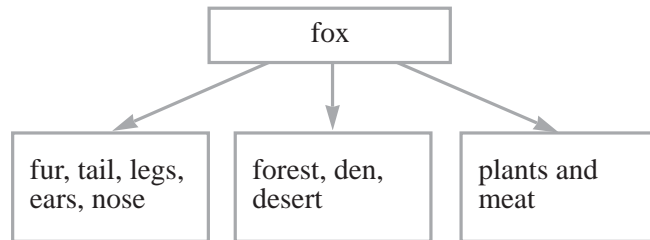


