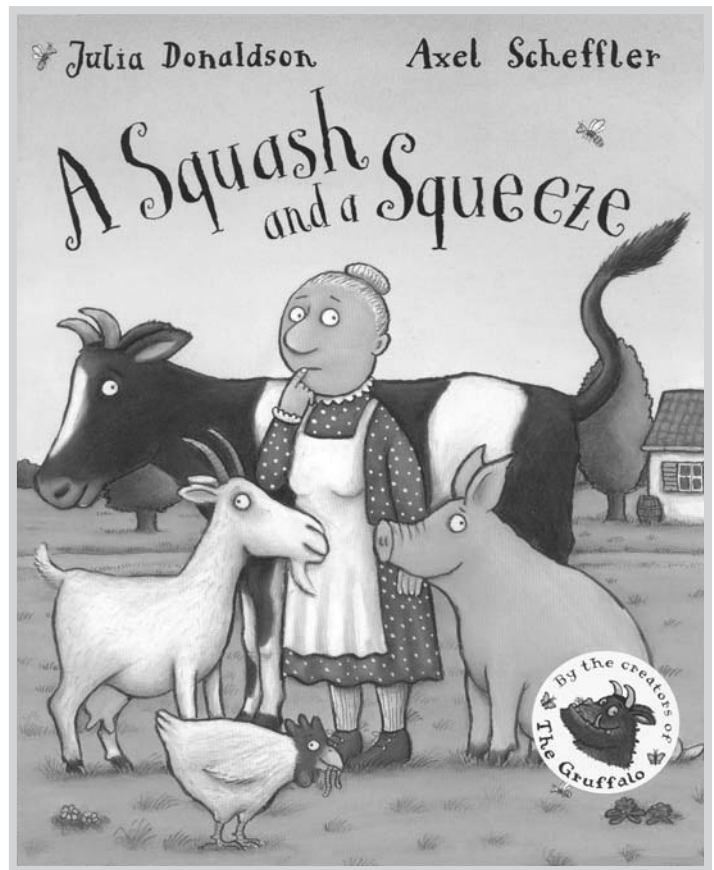

(solution)

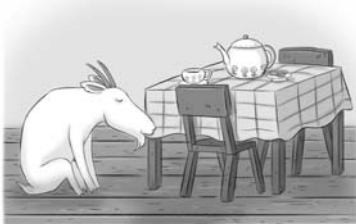
She took the animals all out. It made her feel very good and happy. And she knew her house was not small.
