1. Background Knowledge

Mom: What did I say about your worrying?

Mom: How are things at school now?

Child: I have made many friends. They are all really nice!

Mom: That's good news!

2. Picture Walking

[Cover Page]

Mom: Take a look at this cover!

What do you see?

Child: A boy and a house.

Mom: The boy and the house are unusual.

What is strange about them?

Child: The boy's face is blue.

And I see a bear and fish through the windows.

Mom: Can you guess what season it is?

Child: It is winter.

Mom: Why do you think that?

Child: The boy is wearing a parka.

Mom: Look at the first picture of this story.

We can see the boy from the cover.

What is the boy holding?

Child: I think it's a present.

Mom: Where might the boy be going?

Child: He might be going to a birthday party.

Mom: How do you think the boy feels?

Child: He looks a little nervous and worried.

[Page 6~7]

Mom: Let's look at the next page.

Who are they?

Child: The boy and his mum.

Mom: What are they doing?

Child: They are talking.

Mom: Look at the page on the right.

What are they doing?

Child: Maybe they're looking for a place.

Mom: Is it day or night?

Child: It's night.

Mom: How do you know that?

Child: It's dark, and I see the moon.

Mom: Look at the sky. Something is weird.

What is unusual?

Child: The clouds look like UFOs and the moon looks like an alien.

Mom: Turn to the next pages.

The mum and the boy look inside a house.

What do you see in the house?

Child: I see an old man, an old woman, and a dog.

Mom: Are they normal?

Child: No, they aren't.

Mom: Why do you think that?

Child: The old man and the dog have antennas!

Mom: OK, next page. The mum and the boy are talking and walking down the street.

Child: They find another house.

Mom: Can you guess what is inside the house?

Child: I don't know exactly. But I feel a little scared.

Mom: OK. Are you ready to see the next pages?

Child: Yes, I am.

Mom: Ta-da! What is this?

Child: It's an elephant. It's very huge.

Mom: Do you think this is the house they are looking for?

Child: No, I don't think so.

Mom: Look on the next page.

They are still looking for a house.

Mom: How do you think the boy feels?

Child: I think he still feels worried.

Mom: They have found another house.

Child: There are some people inside.

Mom: Do you think this is the right house?

Child: Yes, I do.

Mom: Ok, let's find out.

Mom: Turn to the next pages.

What do you see?

Child: There are five boys.

Mom: What are they doing?

Child: They are eating dinner and acting silly.

Mom: Do you think they are being normal?

Child: No, I don't.

Mom: Why do you think that?

Child: The boys eat disgusting things.

Mom: What kinds of things?

Child: I see worms, eyes, live snails, and other weird things...

Mom: Okay. Look at the next page.

Mom: They are still looking for a house.

How do you think the boy feels?

Child: He feels tired and a little angry.

Mom: They have found another house.

Child: There are many people inside.

Mom: Do you think this is the right house?

Child: Yes, I do.

Mom: Ok, let's check it out.

Mom: Turn to the next pages.

What do you see?

Child: There are many boys.

Mom: What are they doing?

Child: They are playing.

Mom: Are they playing gently?

Child: No, they aren't.

Mom: And look! There are many snakes. They look very dangerous.

Would you want to play with them?

Child: No, I wouldn't.

Mom: Next page! The boy seems more worried.

Do you think the boy is a worrier?

Child: Yes, I do.

Mom: Look at the page on the right.

They've found another house.

Do you think this is the house they're looking for?

Child: I don't know now.

Mom: Ok, let's look at the next page.

[Page 24~25]

Mom: Maybe that wasn't the house either.

The boy seems like he is going back home.

Look at the boy's face. How does the boy feel?

Child: He looks happy and relieved.

Mom: But Mum is still thinking.

Look at the page on the right.

The door of the house opens...

Do you think they have the right house this time?

Child: Maybe...

Mom: OK, check out the next page.

Mom: You're right!

The boy's friends are at the door. They welcome the boy.

Can you guess how the boy feels now?

Child: He feels confused?

Mom: Look at the page on the right.

How does Mum feel?

Child: She looks worried.

Mom: What is Mum worried about?

Child: Mum is worried about her son at the party.

Mom: Look at the next page.

Mum has come back to get her son.

Can you guess what will happen next?

Child: The boy will be crying.

Mom: Let's find out what the conclusion is.

- Who are the main characters?
- What were the boy and his mum doing?
- How did the boy feel when they were trying to find the house?
- What did the mum say about her son's worrying?
- How many houses did they come across?
- What was going on in each house?
- Can you describe each house in order?
- Did the mum and her son finally find the right house?
