## Five Little Ducks

## 1. Background Knowledge

- 다섯 마리 오리들이 사라졌다 찾는 과정에서 벌어지는 이야기입니다. 숫자 1 에서 5 까지 적힌 숫자 카드를 준비하고 카드를 가리키며 숫자를 세고 읽어 봅니다.

Mom: I have five fingers. Look(자신의 손을 가리키며 손가락 하나씩 센다.) One, two, three, four, and five. What about you?
Child: (아이의 손을 하나씩 짚어주며 함께 세어봅니다.) One, two, three, four, and five.
Mom: You have five fingers too.

## 2. Picture Walking

## [Cover Page]

Mom: Listen. "Quack, quack, quack, quack." There is Mother Duck and her baby ducks. How many baby ducks are there?
Mom \& Child: One, two, three, four, and five.
Mom: There are five baby ducks. The book's title is "Five Little Ducks", illustrated by Yuni Park. Let's see what happened to the five little ducks.

Mom: Five little ducks went out to play. They played hide-and-seek. Mother Duck worked in the garden and quacked. How many little ducks came back?

Mom \& Child: One, two, three...four.
Mom: Only four little ducks came back. One was missing. Which one was missing?
Child: The one that was "it" was missing.
Mom: Where did it go?
[Page 8~9]
Mom: Four little ducks were out playing. Mother Duck made a bed at home and quacked. Look at the window. Little ducks were coming back. How many ducks were coming? Mom \& Child: One, two... three.

Mom: Only three little ducks came back. One was missing. Which one was missing?
Child: The one that was "it" was missing.
Mom: I wonder where it went.
[Page 10~11]
Mom: Three little ducks went to swim in the pond. They jumped, swam, and splashed in the pond. Mother Duck had tea time at home and quacked. Then some little ducks came back. How many little ducks came back?

Mom \& Child: One... two!
Mom: Only two little ducks came back. One was missing. Which one was missing?
Child: The one who had the red ribbon was missing.
Mom: How many little ducks went missing?
Child: Three of them.
Mom: I wonder where they went. Look outside the window. It got darker and darker.
[Page 12~13]
Mom: Two little ducks went out to play. They were jumping up and down. Mother Duck jumped rope in the yard and quacked. How many little ducks came back?

Mom \& Child: One.
Mom: Only one little duck came back. One was missing. Which one was missing?
Child: The one who wore the black hat was missing.
Mom: How many little ducks are missing now?
Child: Four of them.
Mom: I wonder where they went...
[Page 14~15]
Mom: One little duck went out for a walk. It played with a worm. Mother Duck cooked dinner in the kitchen and quacked. How many little ducks came back?

Mom \& Child: None of them came back.
[Page 16~17]
Mom: How did Mother Duck feel when none of her little ducks came home?

Child: She must have been very sad.
Mom: That's right. Sad Mother Duck went out to call her little ducks.
Child: There is a wolf behind the bushes.
Mom: Uh-oh. She had to call her little ducks, so she quacked four times. Let's call her five little ducks together.
Mom \& Child: Quack, quack, quack, quack.
Mom: Do you think all five ducks came home?
Child: Yes.

## 3. Comprehension Check Up

Mom: Who went out to play?
Child: Five little ducks went out to play.
Mom: Where did they play?
Child: They played over the hills and far away.
Mom: How did Mother Duck call for her little ducks?
Child: Mother Duck quacked for her little ducks.
Mom: How many ducks came back at first?
Child: Only four came back.
Mom: Then how many ducks came back?
Child: Only three came back.
Mom: How many ducks came back next?
Child: Only two came back.
Mom: Then how many ducks came back?
Child: Only one came back.
Mom: How many ducks came back after this?
Child: None of them came back.
Mom: How did Mother Duck feel?
Child: She felt sad.
Mom: That's right. What did Mother Duck do then?
Child: She quacked and all five little ducks came home.

## 4. Activities

## 1) 'Where Am I Going?' Game

Mom: What's your favorite farm animal?
Child: The pig.
Mom: Then how does a mother pig call for her little pigs?
Child: She says, "Oink, oink, oink!"
Mom: Excellent!

Mom: Three fingers went out to play. One finger did not come back. (손가락 두 개를 보여 주며) How many fingers came back?

Child: One... two fingers came back.
Mom: Two fingers went out to play. One finger did not come back. (손가락 한 개를 보여주 며) How many fingers came back?
Child: One finger came back.
Mom: One finger went out to play. Do you think it will come back?
Child: No.
Mom: That's right. None of them came back.
