1. Background Knowledge

2. Picture Walking

[Cover Page]

Mom: What do you see on the cover?

Child: I see a bird, a bunny, a pig, a tree, a sheep, a ghost, a squirrel,

a candle and an ice cream cone.

Mom: What color are they?

Child: They are white.

Mom: What other color do you see?

Child: Blue.

[Title Page]

Mom: What color do you see here?

Child: Blue.

Mom: Blue again? What can that be?

Child: No idea!

Mom: We may be able to figure out what it is as we look at all the pictures.

[Page 4-5] Spilt Milk

Mom: This book is very interesting.

The colors we see in it are only white and?

Child: Blue.

Mom: That's right. It is a very special book, isn't it?

Anyway, what do you see on this page?

Child: Spilt water?

Mom: It looks like it, doesn't it?

Let's see what we find on the next page.

[Page 6-7] Rabbit

Mom: What is it? It's obvious.

Child: It's a rabbit.

Mom: That's right. It looks like it. But is it really a rabbit?

[Page 8-9] Bird

Mom: It looks like an animal too.

Child: It's a bird.

Mom: Are you sure it is a bird?

[Page 10-11] Tree Mom: What is it?

Child: A tree!

Mom: I've seen green trees a lot. But I've never seen white trees.

Have you ever seen a white tree?

[Page 12-13] Ice cream cone

Mom: What is it anyway? Is it some kind of smoke?

Or is it an ice cream cone? Child: An ice cream cone!

Mom: Are you sure?

[Page 14-15] Flower

Mom: It is an interesting picture. What can this be?

Child: It's a flower.

Mom: I'm afraid to say that it is not a flower.

What else can it be? Can you guess?

[Page 16-17] Pig

Mom: There is another animal shape here. What does it look like?

Child: A pig!

Mom: Right! It looks like a pig. But it isn't a pig.

[Page 18-19] Cake

Mom: What does this white thing look like?

Child: A candle!

Mom: There is something under it.

Child: A cake!

Mom: Yes, it looks like a cake. But it isn't.

[Page 20-21] Sheep

Mom: What does it look like?

Child: A sheep!

Mom: Sure! But it is not a sheep.

[Page 22-23] Great horned owl

Mom: What is this strange creature?

Child: A ghost!

Mom: Let me give you a clue! It doesn't sleep at night.

Child: An owl!

Mom: It looks like an owl, but it isn't.

Mom: You need this to make a snowman.

Child: A mitten!

Mom: It does look like a mitten. But it is not a mitten.

Mom: Can you imagine what shape it is?

Child: A squirrel!

Mom: Yeah, it looks like it.

Mom: What does it look like?

Child: An angel!

Mom: It looks like an angel. But it isn't. Do you want to know what it is?

- Could you show me the page?
- Why do you like this page the most?
- Have you ever seen clouds that look like something else?

4. Activity

1) Phonemic Awareness

2) Phonics
