Cover

Hey, what do you see here?

I see two children. This is Nick and this is Sue.

Let's say hello to them.

Hello Nick, hello Sue!

The weather is sunny so they are wearing sunglasses.

What are they doing?

Right, they are eating ice cream.

Look, I see some letters on the ice cream.

Can you read the letters?

A, B, C, D, E, F, G

Today we will read about the alphabet.

Say al-pha-bet.

Good!

The title says alphabet ice cream.

Page 1-2

A

Here is Sue. She is eating something.

What is she eating?

Right, she is eating an **A**pple.

Listen again Ap-ple.

The beginning sound is /æ/.

The letter has /æ/ sound. **A**pple.

B

Look, there is something on Nick's head.

It's a **B**at.

But Nick is not afraid.

And what is flying here?

Right, a **B**utterfly.

Bat and butterfly begin with the same sound.

The letter B has /b/ sound.

Bat, **B**utterfly.

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C

Here is the letter C. C makes the /k/ sound.

What begins with the /k/ sound? **S**ky?

No, what about this? **C**rocodile?

Yes, Camel? Yes, and Cat!

Can you find more words that begin with the /k/ sound?

Bingo! Cup and Cloud.

D

Look, Nick and Sue are in the digger.

Digger begins with this letter D.

D has /d/ sound. Digger.

Be careful Nick and Sue!

There is a Dandelion.

Ah ha, dandelion has the /d/ sound just like digger.

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E

Now what is Sue eating?

She's eating an egg.

I see the letter E.

E has the /e/ sound like Egg.

Here are two animal pictures.

One is a frog and the other one is an elephant.

Which one begins with the same sound like Egg?

Frog or Elephant?

Right, elephant.

F

I see another letter.

F makes the /f/ sound.

Say it with me /f/.

Nick is eating fish fingers with a fork.

Fish, finger, fork.

Do they begin with F? Yes!

G

Look, Nick is playing with a grasshopper.

The letter G makes the /g/ sound.

Grasshopper.

Have you ever seen a Grasshopper?

H

What letter do you see here? This is H.

H makes the /h/ sound.

Buzz, the bees make Honey.

Do you like to eat Honey? Me too!

I

Now Nick and Sue are eating ice cream!

The letter I makes the /ai/ sound.

Ice cream.

Listen, island.

Do you think island begins with the letter I?

Yes!

J

Now I see Jelly and Jug.

Can you hear the beginning sound?

What's that? Right, /dʒ/ sound.

The letter J makes the / dʒ/ sound .

Jelly, Jug!

Q

Who is this?

Right, this is a Queen.

Queen and quack begin with the letter Q.

Q makes the /q/ sound like Queen and Quack.

R

R makes the /r/ sound like Rose.

What about Rain? Does it begin with R?

Yes! Rose and Rain!

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S

Do you know this letter?

Right, it's the letter S.

S makes the /s/ sound.

Sue and spaghetti begin with the letter S.

Is there another one that begin with the /s/ sound?

What's that? Right , Star! Great!

T

What do you see here?

I see a long Track, Train, and a Tortoise.

Can you hear the same beginning sound in Track, Train, and Tortoise.

Right, it's the /t/ sound .

The letter t makes the /t/ sound.

Track, Train, and Tortoise.

This letter is U and this animal begins with U.

Unicorn.

V

The next letter is V.

V makes the /v/ sound.

Look, Nick looks like a Viking.

Viking begins with letter V. Vroom!

Volcano begins with V too.

The next letter is W. W makes the /w/ sound.

Let's find words that begin with W.

X

This letter is.... X .

Right, the whales kiss.

X means kiss.

Nick and Sue are eating yoghurt.

Do you like yoghurt?

I think Nick likes yoghurt because he says **Yum!**

But Sue doesn't like yoghurt because she says **Yuk!**

This letter is Y. Yoghurt, Yum, and Yuk all begin with Y.

Can you tell me the sound of Y?

Yes, **Yoghurt, Yum and Yuk!**

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Z

This is the last letter of alphabet, Z.

Z makes the /z/ sound.

Nick and Sue are in a rocket. They are flying into the space very fast.

Zoom! Do you know more words that begin with Z?

Zoo and zebra. Very good.

Now we learned all 24 alphabet letters.
