Red Rockets and Rainbow Jelly

1. Background Knowledge

- 이 책에서는 Nick 과 Sue 가 서로 좋아하는 것들을 색깔과 함께 이야기 합니다. 서로 다른 물건들을 좋아하지만 마지막에는 서로를 좋아하고 있다는 내용으로 끝이 납니다. Nick 과 Sue 가 하나하나 물건이나 음식을 이야기할 때 아이도 그 물건을 좋아하는지, 아니면 다른 것을 좋아하는지 이야기해 봅니다. 아이와 친한 친구는 어떤 것을 좋아하는지 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: What is your favorite color?
Child: I like blue.
Mom: What things do you have that are blue?
Child: I have a blue umbrella and a blue jacket.
Mom: Who is your best friend?
Child: My best friend is Shi Woo.
Mom: Does he also have a blue umbrella?
Child: Yes, he does.
Mom: Oh, really? Does he also have a blue jacket?
Child: No. He has a green jacket.
Mom: So you and your friend wear different colors! But is he still your best friend?
Child: Yes, he is.

2. Picture Walking

[Cover Page] Mom: Look at the cover. What do you see? Child: I see a rocket. Mom: What color is the rocket? Child: It is red. Mom: What do you think these are? Child: I think they are mountains. Mom: Look at the title: "Red Rockets and Rainbow Jelly". Now what can they be? Child: Rainbow jelly? Mom: Maybe. We will see after reading this book.

[p. 4-5]

Mom: There is a boy and a girl. What are their names?

Child: Nick and Sue.

Mom: Right. How do they look?

Child: They look happy.

Mom: Yes. You see they are smiling. Who do you think they are? Do you think they are friends? Brother and sister?

Child: I think they are friends.

[p. 6-7]

Mom: Let's turn to the next page. Nick is eating something. What do you think it is?

Child: I think it is an apple.

Mom: I think so, too! There are apple trees behind him. Some apples are on the ground. Sue is holding a basket of pears. What does Nick like? What does Sue like?

Child: Nick likes red apples, and Sue likes green pears.

Mom: What fruit do you like?

Child: I like red apples.

Mom: Oh, you like red apples! We had them a couple of days ago. Would you like to eat green pears, too?

Child: No.

[p. 8-9]

Mom: Do you see Nick? He is standing upside down! He seems to be in the living room. There is a white door, a lamp, and a mat. What is Nick wearing? Child: He is wearing yellow socks, red shorts, and a blue and white t-shirt.

Mom: Nick likes yellow socks. Is yellow your favorite color, too?

Child: No. I like green.

Mom: Now look at Sue. What does she have on her head?

Child: Sue has yellow ducks.

Mom: Yes. They are yellow rubber ducks. What do you think Sue is doing?

Child: She is taking a bath.

[p. 10-11]

Mom: Nick is wearing a long wig. Sue is wearing a curly wig. Do you like these wigs? Child: Yes, I do.

Mom: If you can have a wig, what color would you like it to be?

Child: I want a yellow wig.

[p. 12-13]

Mom: There are a lot of purple flowers in the picture. Sue is wearing a purple necklace and purple sweater. What is not purple in the picture?Child: The leaves and Sue's dress.Mom: Right. What flowers are purple? Can you name a few?Child: Violets, tulips, ...

Mom: Great! Morning glories and pansies are purple, too.

[p. 14-15]

Mom: There are two bears dancing. They are holding hands. There are many black cats, too. How does Nick look?

Child: He looks happy.

Mom: Do you like brown bears and black cats, too?

Child: Yes, I do.

Mom: Will Sue like brown bears and black cats, too?

Child: Maybe something different.

Mom: That's what I think, too! She likes different things and different colors! Let's see what Sue likes.

[p. 16-17]

Mom: What are these?

Child: They are cats.

Mom: The cats are black and white. Some cats have dots, and some cats have stripes. They are wearing black and white hats. They all look different. Which one of these hats do you like the best?

Child: I like this one.

[p. 18-19]

Mom: Now you see cars. Nick is driving a red car. A white mouse and a black cat are also driving. You can also see some airplanes in the sky. What color are the airplanes?

Child: One is pink and orange, and the other is yellow and green.

Mom: Right. Sue is driving a pink and orange car. A dog is driving a car, too. What color car would you like to drive when you grow up?

Child: I would like to drive a red car.

Mom: Where Nick is driving, the street is up high. It must be a big city. But Sue is driving on a road where you can see grass, trees, and some animals. What animals do you see? **Child:** I see rabbits and birds.

Mom: Yes. The black birds look like crows. Where would you enjoy driving – in a big city, or in the country?

Child: I would enjoy driving in a big city.

[p. 20-21]
Mom: What do you see?
Child: I see dinosaurs!
Mom: Yes. These dinosaurs are huge. They are running fast. Nick is riding on one of them. How does Nick look?
Child: He looks happy/scared.
Mom: Be careful, Nick! Would you enjoy riding a dinosaur?
Child: Yes/No.
Mom: What color would you make your dinosaur?
Child: I would make it green and brown.

[p. 22-23]

Mom: Now we are in space. There is a big rocket. What is inside the rocket?

Child: There is a red dog.

Mom: Right. You see some other red dogs on this planet. Do you think it could be the Moon? **Child:** Yes.

Mom: Look at Sue! She's not walking. She is floating. Would you like to travel into space?

Child: Yes, I would.

Mom: What color would you like your rocket to be?

Child: I would like it to be blue.

[p. 24-25]

Mom: What are these?

Child: They are aliens.

Mom: What color are they?

Child: Some are green, and some are green and yellow.

Mom: Which one do you like better?

Child: I like these ones.

Mom: No one has seen real aliens before, but would you like to go to space and meet aliens? Why?

Child: Yes/No. (Answers may vary.)

[p. 26-27]

Mom: Nick is jumping on the top of this mountain. The mountains are so high that you see some white clouds at the top. Do you think they are real mountains? What is strange about them?
Child: I don't think they are real mountains because the colors are different.
Mom: It says they are different colors of jelly! You love jelly, don't you?
Child: Yes/No.
Mom: What is your favorite flavor?
Child: I like strawberry and orange.

[p. 28-29]

Mom: Now look at Sue! Where is she?

Child: She is by the sea/at the beach.

Mom: Many things are blue, but some things are not blue. Can you name the things that are blue?

Child: The birds, the flag, the camera, the bag, and the teddy bear.

Mom: Great job! The sea is blue, too! But the sand is yellow. Would you like to keep everything blue like Sue?

Child: No.

Mom: It is great to have other colors, too.

Mom: We see Sue and Nick again! What does it say?

Child: Sue likes Nick. Nick likes Sue.

Mom: Right! They like each other, although they like different things and different colors! Do you also like your friend even if he likes different things?

Child: Yes.

Mom: Great! Your friend can like different things but you can still like him.

1) Compare and Contrast chart 만들어 보기

책을 보면서 Nick 과 Sue 가 좋아하는 것들을 그려 보거나 적어 봅니다. 맨 오른쪽 칸에는 아이가 좋아하는 것을 그려 봅니다. 차트를 완성한 후 발표해 봅니다.

2) Show and Tell

상자 안에 자신이 좋아하는 물건들 몇 가지를 담아 보게 합니다. 하나씩 꺼내서 그 물건에 대해 색깔과 이름 등을 말해 보게 합니다.

3) Rainbow color 를 이용하여 그림 그리기

Rainbow 색깔의 색종이를 뜯어 붙이며 큰 그림을 완성하게 하거나 색연필/크레용을 사용하여 무지개 색으로 큰 그림을 색칠하게 해 봅니다. 그림은 책에 나온 물건이나 아이가 좋아하는 다른 그림을 사용합니다. 다 그린 후에 색깔을 짚어 가며 이야기해 봅니다.
