1. Background Knowledge

이 책은 딸이 엄마의 어렸을 적부터 자신을 낳을 때까지의 사진을 구경하는 내용입니다. 아이가
 어렸을 적 사진과 부모님의 옛날 사진들을 함께 보면서 그 모습이 어땠는지 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: This is a photo of your dad when he was small. Does it look like your dad?Child: A little. But he looks different.Mom: Who do you think this is?Child: Mom?Mom: Right. This was when I was a schoolgirl. Who is this?

Child: That's me! I've seen this photo before.

2. Picture Walking

[cover page]

Mom: Look at the cover. What do you see?

Child: I see two people and flowers.

Mom: One person looks big, and the other looks smaller. Who do you think they are?

Child: Mother and daughter.

Mom: I think so, too. See how they are wearing the same hat, and the same color of clothes. What are they doing?

Child: They are sitting on a bench.

Mom: Right. They might be talking about flowers or the field. They might be just sitting there quietly and looking at the beautiful scenery. What does the title say?

Child: It says "This Quiet Lady."

Mom: Who can the quiet lady be?

Child: I think it is the mother.

Mom: Well, we'll see. Let's read the book and find out more about them.

Mom: Who is this girl looking at the photo? Is she the mother or the daughter?

Child: She is the daughter.

Mom: Who is this baby?

Child: It is the mother.

Mom: Right. The girl is looking at the photo of her mother when she was a baby. Where is the baby?

Child: The baby is in her bassinette.

Mom: Right. The baby is smiling in her bassinette under the crocheted throw. The baby's mother probably knitted the throw for her.

Mom: Now the girl is looking at a photo in an album. Who is this girl in the blue dress?

Child: She is the mother.

Mom: Yes. The baby has grown a bit. What does she have in her hand?

Child: She has a doll.

Mom: Yes. It says the doll is drooping from her hand. See how the girl's dress and the doll's dress look similar. Look at the collar! Their shoes are the same, too! The doll looks pretty much the same as the girl.

Mom: The girl is looking at another photo on the dresser. What is she looking at?

Child: She is looking at an untidy schoolgirl.

Mom: Why do you think it says she is untidy?

Child: The buttons are wrong.

Mom: Oh, she didn't button her coat right. She's wearing only one mitten, and her boots are loose, too. Her stockings are wrinkled. She looks quite untidy.

Mom: Now the schoolgirl has grown to be a young lady. Who is she with?

Child: She is with boys.

Mom: They look like they are having a party, playing music and having fun. What is this boy giving the lady?

Child: He is giving her a flower.

Mom: Right. These boys seem to like her.

Mom: What happened to the mother?

Child: She graduated from school.

Mom: Yes. She doesn't look untidy any more. She is dressed in a cap and gown. She has a diploma in her hand, and a bunch of flowers.

Mom: Wow! What happened to the mother?

Child: She is wearing a wedding dress!

Mom: Right! She got married. This bride like a white flower is her mother. A long time ago, wedding dresses looked like this.

Mom: We see that this mother is with someone now. Who is he?

Child: He is the girl's father.

Mom: Right. The father's arm is around her. They seem to be traveling. Where do you think they are?

Child: They are in Paris!

Mom: Here we see the mother again, a quiet lady, lovely and large. How does she look?

Child: She looks happy.

Mom: Where is she right now?

Child: She is on the front porch.

Mom: This must be a lovely house with a lovely garden.

[page 20-21]

Mom: Tada! What happened in this picture?

Child: A baby was born.

Mom: Who is this baby?

Child: It is the girl.

Mom: Right! The girl was born, and the mother is holding her in her arms. This is how she began.

Have you seen your baby photos?

Child: Yes!

Mom: The beginning. This is the beginning of the girl. She is a girl looking at photos right now, but she will also grow to be a lady. Will she be a beautiful young lady like her mother? **Child:** Yes. I think so.

3. Comprehension Check-up

Mom: In this book you saw many pictures of the mother. Where did the story begin?
Child: We saw a baby in a bassinette.
Mom: Great! It started with a baby's photo. What came next?
Child: There was a small girl and then a schoolgirl.
Mom: Right. There was a small girl with a doll, and the untidy girl. What came next?
Child: We saw the mom with boys, and the graduation photo.
Mom: Excellent! After she graduated, she got married. There was a photo of a beautiful bride's photo, then one of a woman. What happened last?

Child: The baby was born.

Mom: Right! The baby was the girl who was looking at her mother's photos.

4. Activity

1) Read Aloud

2) Pronunciation – Syllable Counting
