# Merry Christmas, Big Hungry Bear

# 1. Background Knowledge

- 'The Little Mouse, the Red Ripe Strawberry, and the Big Hungry Bear'의 후속편입니다. '크리스마스' 하면 떠오르는 것에 대해 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: Christmas is coming. What come with Christmas?
Child: Santa Claus! Presents!
Mom: Umm... Did you get any Christmas presents last year?
Child: Yes! Santa Claus gave me lots of candy.
Mom: Wow! But look at this picture.
Have you ever seen the man with the red bucket ringing a bell in the street? When did you see him? What is this red bucket for?
Child: I have seen him. Dad and I put some money in the bucket last winter.
Mom: Right. You did it last year.
People put some money into this bucket. Do you know why?
Child: To help?
Mom: Yes. Jesus came to the world to share love on Christmas.
So Christmas is not only for fun.
You need to think about sharing with others.

# 2. Picture Walking

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Mom: Who is he? Do you remember this little mouse from "The Little Mouse, The Red Ripe Strawberry, and the Big Hungry Bear"?
Child: I know, I know.
Mom: What can you see in the picture?
Child: Presents! A Christmas tree!

[Title Page ] **Mom:** He is smiling with lots of presents. Maybe it's Christmas. The little mouse is wearing a red hat like Santa Claus. How cute! He is carrying boxes of presents. Where is he going? Child: To the hungry bear? Mom: The bear? Let's read on. Merry Christmas, Big Hungry Bear!

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Mom: Home! Do you remember this little door? Where is it?

Child: The Mouse's home!

**Mom:** Yes. In "The Red Ripe Strawberry", the mouse came out from the house with a ladder, but now he is going into the house with presents. Then, what picture would you see on next page? **Child:** Inside the house.

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Mom: Right! The mouse is standing with......
Wow! so many presents! How might he feel?
Child: Happy.
Mom: Then what happens next?
Child: He will be surprised? As "The Red Ripe Strawberry"?

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Mom: You are so smart! Right. He is surprised. Why?

Child: The big hungry bear!

**Mom:** Someone is talking about the big hungry bear who loves Christmas presents. So what should he do?

Child: Hide!

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**Mom:** What did he do? He hid them under the blanket and wrapped up with chains. And what else can he do to keep them?

Child: Disguise them

Mom: Yes! He spread tacks on the floor! But he didn't have to.

The big hungry bear will not come.

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Mom: Where is the mouse? Can you see? Here is his long tail.

He hid under the blanket. What will happen next?

Look at the picture carefully.

Child: Big hungry bear will come out! He will eat the mouse!

## 3. Comprehension Check-up

mouse 감정 읽기 - 생쥐의 감정 변화에 대해 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: How do you feel today? Child: Good. (happy, sad, angry, surprised 등을 이용해 이야기를 끌어주세요.) Mom: Look at the face of the mouse. The changing feeling on his face tells the story. At the beginning of the story, how might he feel? Child: Happy. He got so many presents. Mom: On next picture, how might he feel? Child: Surprised!

# 4. Activity

#### 1) Read Aloud

- 특히 대문자로 된 부분 BOO HOO HOO, PLOP... 부분을 강조해 감정을 살려서 읽어 봅니다.

## 2) Phonemic Awareness

- 책에 나오는 단어를 Onset & Rime으로 끊어 읽어 봅니다.

## 3) Vocabulary

- 명사 앞에 형용사를 붙이는 연습을 해봅니다.

Mom: How is the mouse? Is he brave or a coward?Child: Brave.Mom: Yes. He is brave. And is he big? Or is he little?Child: He is little.Mom: Good. He is brave and he is little. He is the brave, little mouse.
