

Knuffle Bunny Free

1. Background Knowledge

- 이 책은 Trixie가 애착 인형 Knuffle Bunny를 잃어버렸다가 다시 찾고, Knuffle Bunny를 다른 아이에게 선물하기까지 Trixie가 심적으로 성장하는 모습을 다룬 이야기입니다.

아이와 비행기나 기차 등을 타고 먼 곳으로 여행해 본 경험이나 소중한 물건을 잃어버렸던 기억을 이야기해 봅니다.

Mom: Do you remember that we traveled to Jeju Island when you were three years old?

Child: Yes.

Mom: How did you feel on the plane?

Child: I was very excited.

Mom: Can you tell me what you remember doing in Jeju?

Child: I remember the beach. I played in the sand by the seashore.

Mom: Wow! I'm glad that you still remember playing by the sea. Have you ever lost something that you really liked?

Child: I have lost my shoes at a restaurant. Somebody took my shoes and some similar shoes were there instead.

Mom: How did you feel then?

Child: I felt annoyed and sad.

2. Picture Walking

Mom: Look at the cover. What do you see?

Child: I see a girl carrying a stuffed bunny and her parents.

Mom: Great! The person behind her looks like her mom, and the next person looks like her dad. They are all walking down the street carrying some bags. Where do you think they are going?

Child: I don't know.

Mom: We will see what happens in the book.

Mom: We have some pictures here. Can you tell me what you see in the first photo?

Child: The man and the woman are getting married.

Mom: Good! It looks like a wedding photo. What happened in the second picture?

Child: They have a baby.

Mom: Right! A baby was born. What about the picture below the second one?

Child: The father is carrying the baby. The mother is smiling next to him.

Mom: Good job! In the next three photos we can see Knuffle Bunny. This baby girl is growing up with the bunny. In the last and the biggest photo, where do you think the girl is?

Child: She is inside a bus or a plane.

Mom: Good guess! She is looking back at the person behind her from her seat. Let's turn the page.

Mom: Now we know where the family is headed. Where are they going?

Child: They are going to Holland.

Mom: What are they going to do?

Child: They are going to take a taxi.

Mom: Great job! What do you think "Oma" and "Opa" mean?

Child: Grandma and Grandpa.

Mom: Good! You can also guess who they are from the picture. They must be Trixie's grandmother and grandfather.

Mom: Look! This is how they take the airplane. First they take a taxi to the airport, queue up, watch their luggage go through the scanner, wait some more, and get on the plane! How does Trixie look when she is finally on the plane?

Child: She looks happy.

Mom: Right. She looks very excited. What does she have?

Child: She has a bag and her Knuffle Bunny.

Mom: Yes. That's right.

Mom: It is a long flight from America to Holland. What did Trixie do on the plane?

Child: She played, read, and slept.

Mom: Right. Then the plane landed. Trixie's father is waking her up. What did they take next?

Child: They took a train.

Mom: Good!

Mom: They took the train to Oma and Opa's house. See how they are welcoming Trixie! What did Oma give Trixie?

Child: She gave her a cold glass of chocolate milk.

Mom: Right. That must have been very refreshing after the long trip. But suddenly Trixie realized something. What do you think it was?

Child: She doesn't have Knuffle Bunny.

Mom: Trixie didn't have to say anything to her dad. She just looked at him like this and her daddy knew. How do you think that was possible?

Child: I think her daddy knows how important Knuffle Bunny is to her.

Mom: Wonderful!

Mom: So what did her daddy do?

Child: He called the airline.

Mom: Right. And he found out that their plane had left for a very far away land! Where was it?

Child: It was China.

Mom: Do you think it is possible to find Knuffle Bunny again?

Child: No.

Mom: Trixie's family tried their best to comfort her. What did her mummy do?

Child: She hugged her and asked her to be brave.

Mom: Great! Her daddy told her a story of when he had to say goodbye to his favorite toy. What was its name?

Child: Special Lamby.

Mom: Right. And Oma remarked on how big she was getting.

Mom: Trixie understood that she was getting bigger, but she didn't want to. How did the family spend the next day?

Child: They went to the café, the playground, and the carnival.

Mom: Great! They had a lot of fun. Do you think Trixie felt a little better?

Child: No. She doesn't look happy.

Mom: Right. She's still not smiling.

Mom: The rest of the week was filled with fun things. What were the fun things they did?

Child: Eating chips on the street, visiting windmills, and feeding ducks.

Mom: Great! But how did Trixie feel?

Child: She was still sad.

Mom: Right. So Oma and Opa had a plan. I wonder what they were going to do.

Mom: What was Oma and Opa's plan?

Child: To get her a new toy.

Mom: Right. It was a wonderful robot bunny that could do many things. Did Trixie like it?

Child: No, she didn't.

Mom: Trixie still missed her Knuffle Bunny but soon fell asleep. Maybe she was very tired. Let's look inside these pages.

Mom: What did Trixie dream of?

Child: She dreamed of Knuffle Bunny.

Mom: Right. She dreamed how her Knuffle Bunny would visit many places and meet many children. She dreamed how her Knuffle Bunny would make them feel better.

Mom: How did Trixie feel the next morning?

Child: She felt better.

Mom: Right! She is finally smiling.

Mom: It says Trixie had a big breakfast. Do you think Trixie had a big breakfast before this day?

Child: No.

Mom: No, probably not. Maybe up until this day, Trixie wasn't eating well because she was so sad. How is Trixie on the swing?

Child: She is happy.

Mom: She seems to be having fun, even at the café.

Mom: Trixie's trip was over and it was already time to go home. How do you think Trixie feels?

Child: I think She feels sad.

Mom: She was probably sad to say goodbye to Oma and Opa. She hugged them as hard as she could. Then they were back on the train and on the plane.

Mom: Who was sitting behind Trixie?

Child: A baby was.

Mom: Right. The baby was crying when the plane lifted off. What did Trixie notice inside her seat pocket?

Child: Her Knuffle Bunny!

Mom: Her Knuffle Bunny was there! Can you believe it?

Child: Wow!

Mom: What are the chances that Trixie would be back on the same plane, in the same seat as before? And Knuffle Bunny was still there. How did Trixie feel?

Child: She was so happy.

Mom: What did Trixie decide to do?

Child: She gave her Knuffle Bunny to the baby.

Mom: Everyone's reaction was the same. They were asking Trixie "Really?" Why do you think Trixie decided to give her Knuffle Bunny to the baby?

Child: Because she was okay without it.

Mom: Maybe Trixie really has grown up a little.

Mom: Trixie was really giving her Knuffle Bunny to the baby. The baby stopped crying. How did the baby's mother feel?

Child: She was thankful.

Mom: How about Trixie's parents?

Child: They were proud.

Mom: They must have felt really proud of Trixie. The other passengers were relieved because the baby wasn't crying any longer.

Mom: What happened a few weeks later?

Child: Trixie received her first letter.

Mom: Who was the letter from?

Child: It was from the baby's mom.

Mom: Yes. It was a nice thank-you letter with a photo of the baby and Knuffle Bunny.

Child: Trixie.

Mom: Wow! This is what's going to happen to Trixie! Who do you think wrote this note?

Child: Trixie's dad?

Mom: From an old pen pal, Daddy. What did Trixie's daddy send her?

Child: Her Knuffle Bunny!

Mom: Wow! Her daddy must love her very much.

3. Comprehension Check-up

Mom: Where did Trixie's family go?

Child: They went to see Trixie's Oma and Opa in Holland.

Mom: Great! What did they take to get there?

Child: First they took a taxi, then a plane, and a train.

Mom: Right. What did they do at Oma and Opa's house?

Child: They had some chocolate milk.

Mom: Then suddenly, what did Trixie realize?

Child: Knuffle Bunny was gone!

Mom: Right. Where was Knuffle Bunny?

Child: It was in the airplane.

Mom: Right. It seemed almost impossible the family were going to find Knuffle Bunny again. What did the family do to help Trixie forget about her Knuffle Bunny?

Child: They told her stories and had fun together.

Mom: Excellent! They remarked how big she was getting. They spent a lot of time having fun. Did Oma and Opa's present make Trixie feel any better?

Child: No, it didn't.

Mom: Then what changed Trixie's mind?

Child: Her dream about Knuffle Bunny.

Mom: Right. In her dream, Knuffle Bunny made many children happy. What happened on their way home?

Child: They found Knuffle Bunny on the plane, but Trixie gave it to a baby.

Mom: Good job! Trixie missed it so much before, but she was big enough to give her Knuffle Bunny to the baby.
