## Triangle

## 1. Background Knowledge

- 이 책은 세모 모양의 주인공이 네모 모양의 친구를 찾아가 놀려주고, 다시 네모가 세모에게 찾아와 장난을 치는 내용입니다. 친구들에게 장난을 친 적이 있는지 아이와 대화를 나누어 보고,
그 때 친구가 어떻게 반응했는지, 기분이 어땠는지 이야기를 나누어 봅니다.

Mom: Have you ever played a sneaky trick on your friend before?
Child: What is a sneaky trick?
Mom: It is when you surprise your friend in some way.
Child: Oh, I have surprised my friend Soomin before. I was hiding behind a door and suddenly jumped out in front of him when he came close.
Mom: How did he react?
Child: Oh, he hated it. He wanted to do the same thing to me.
Mom: How did you feel?
Child: I didn't feel very good.

## 2. Picture Walking

[cover page]
Mom: Look at the cover. What shape do you see?
Child: I see a triangle.
Mom: Right. This triangle has eyes and legs. What do you think the story is about?
Child: I think it is about a triangle that can move around.
Mom: It could be. Let's read the book and find out what the story is about.

Mom: What shape do you see?
Child: I see a triangle.
Mom: This is the same triangle that we saw on the cover. Do you see that Triangle begins with a big $T$ ? This must be his name.

Mom: Where is Triangle?
Child: He is at his house.
Mom: What shape is his house?
Child: It is a triangle.
Mom: Triangle's house is a triangle, too! The rocks around his house look like triangles also.
[page 6-7]
Mom: Where is Triangle now?
Child: He is in his house.
Mom: Right. The picture hanging on the wall is also of a triangle. What shape is his door?
Child: It is a triangle.
Mom: So Triangle fits in there perfectly!

Mom: Now he is outside his house. Where is he going?
Child: He is going to his friend, Square.
Mom: What is he going to do?
Child: He is going to play a sneaky trick on Square.
Mom: I wonder what he will do. Let's read on.
[page 10-11]
Mom: What do you see along the way?
Child: Small triangles, medium triangles, and big triangles.
Mom: Right. These can be rocks or mountains. Whatever they may be, they are all triangles.
[page 12-13]
Mom: Here we see some triangles, but there are no more triangles here. It says they are shapes that weren't triangles any more. What do you think they are?
Child: I think they are just regular rocks.
Mom: I think so, too. Triangle has walked a long way, away from his house where everything is triangle shaped.

Mom: Now these look like rocks and waterfalls. Do you see any triangles here?

Child: No.
Mom: Rocks here are shapes with no names. They look like regular rocks that we see in the nature.

Mom: Now what shapes do you see?
Child: I see squares.
Mom: Right! Triangle walked up to this place where there were squares. Maybe he is getting closer to Square's house.

Mom: What shapes did Triangle walk past?
Child: Big squares, medium squares, and small squares.
Mom: This is exactly the opposite of how he walked past triangles! Do you think he is almost at Square's house?

Child: Yes.

Mom: Did he get to Square's house?
Child: Yes.
Mom: What shape is Square's house?
Child: It's a square.
Mom: What is Triangle going to do?
Child: He is going to play a sneaky trick.
[page 22-23]
Mom: What was Triangle's sneaky trick?
Child: He said "HISS" just like a snake.
Mom: Right. That's what he did. Do you think Square is in his house?
Child: Yes/No.
[page 24-25]
Mom: Where is Square?
Child: He is in his house.
Mom: How does he look?

Child: He looks surprised/scared.
Mom: Was he really scared?
Child: Yes. He was very scared.
Mom: Right. Square is very scared. He thinks there are many snakes out there.

Mom: Where is Square now?
Child: He is outside his house.
Mom: What did he see?
Child: He saw Triangle.
Mom: Right. Square saw Triangle, and he realized that there were no snakes!

Mom: Now nobody is saying anything. What do you think they are thinking?
Child: I think Triangle is thinking "Uh oh..."
Mom: Maybe the two friends needed time to think about what to do next. Do you think Square will get angry at Triangle?

Child: Yes.
[page 30-31]
Mom: What's happening in the picture?
Child: I think Triangle is running away.
Mom: It DOES look like he is running away. Square seems to be following Triangle. What will he do?

Child: He will follow Triangle to his house.
Mom: We'll see what happens.
[page 32-33]
Mom: Now they ran past squares and shapes with no names. What comes next?
Child: Triangles!
Mom: Right. They are running past all the shapes that Triangle walked past before.
[page 34-35]
Mom: What shapes are they running past?
Child: Big triangles, medium triangles, and small triangles.

Mom: Right. Square is following Triangle all the way.
[page 36-37]
Mom: Finally Triangle went into his house! Do you think Square will follow him inside?
Child: Yes.
Mom: Square is right in front of Triangle's door. Let's see what he does next.
[page 38-39]
Mom: It seems like Square has followed Triangle into his house, but it says "almost." It means he didn't really get into it yet. What do you think happened?

Child: I don't know.
[page 40-41]
Mom: He is stuck at the door! Why do you think he is stuck?
Child: Because the door is triangle shaped and Square is square shaped. The door is not big enough.

Mom: Great job! The triangle-shaped door was not big enough for Square to pass through. Uhoh. Now Triangle is laughing hard. Poor Square!

Mom: What problem did Square cause Triangle?
Child: He was blocking the light.
Mom: Why was blocking the light a problem for Triangle?
Child: Triangle was afraid of the dark.
Mom: Right. Square didn't mean to, but he ended up scaring Triangle by blocking the light. Now it looks like he has played a sneaky trick on Triangle. He said it was his plan all along.

Mom: Do you believe it was his plan?
Child: No.
Mom: Why not?
Child: He is still stuck in the door!
Mom: How funny!
3. Comprehension Check-up

Triangle 과 Square 의 이야기를 순서대로 정리해 봅니다.

Mom: Who are the two main characters in this story?
Child: Triangle and Square.
Mom: Great! What did Triangle want to do at the beginning?
Child: He wanted to play a sneaky trick on Square.
Mom: Right. So he went all the way to his friend's house. What did he do at Square's house?
Child: He made noises like a snake.
Mom: Right. So what did Square do?
Child: He chased Triangle to his house.
Mom: Did he get into Triangle's house?
Child: No. He was stuck in the door.
Mom: He was stuck in the door! Maybe he wanted to get into Triangle's house, but he couldn't.
How did Square play a sneaky trick on Triangle?
Child: He was blocking the light and Triangle was afraid of the dark.
Mom: Great job!

## 1) Read Aloud

## 2) Phonemic Awareness

- Beginning [s] and ending [s]

플래시 카드로 빨간 s 와 파란 s 를 각각 만듭니다. 다음 단어를 들려 주고, 단어의 처음에 $[\mathrm{s}$ ]
소리가 들리면 빨간 카드를, 단어의 끝에 [s] 소리가 들리면 파란 카드를 들어 보게 합니다.

## 3) Finding Shapes in the house

- 집 안에 있는 물건들 중 삼각형으로 된 것을 찾아보고 영어로 이름을 말해 봅니다. 또 사각형으로 된 물건들은 어떤 것이 있는지 찾아 봅니다.


## 4) Draw a Map

- Triangle 과 Square 가 사는 곳의 지도를 그려 봅니다. 옆으로 긴 종이에 Triangle 의 집, small triangles, medium triangles, big triangles, shapes with no names, big squares, medium squares, small squares, Square 의 집 순서로 지도를 그려 보고 이야기 속의 Triangle 과 Square 가 각각 어떻게 움직였는지 이야기해 봅니다.


## 5) Vocabulary

1. Shapes Mini Book

- 다양한 모양들을 그리고 각각의 이름을 쓰면서 mini book 을 만들어 봅니다.
(triangle, square, circle, oval, rectangle, star, heart, diamond, etc.)

2. Memory Game

- 다음 모양들을 두 세트씩 카드로 만들어 memory matching game 을 해 봅니다.
(small triangle, medium triangle, big triangle, small square, medium square, big square)


## 6) Arts and Crafts

- Triangle World

- Mosaic
