Little Mole's Wish

1. Background Knowledge

This book is about a little mole and his wish.

Mom: Do you know what a mole is?

Child: No, what is it?

Mom: It's a kind of animal that lives underground.

Child: Oh.

Mom: 두더지는 집을 땅속에 지어서 잘 보이지 않아. It digs its home underground so it isn't seen very well. Can you think of other animals that live underground?

Child: Rabbits? Mice?

Mom: Yes, very good. And do you know what a wish is?

Child: Yes, it's when you want something.

Mom: Right, something you're hoping for. It could be a secret. When do you make a wish?

Child: On my birthday, when I blow out the candles on my birthday cake.

Mom: Right. 그리고 어떤 사람들은 별똥별을 보고 소원을 빌기도 한단다. And some people make a wish when they see a shooting star.

2. Picture Walking

[Cover Page]

Mom: Look at the cover. What do you see?

Child: I see a little animal with a red hat on and yellow mittens. It's looking up at the sky. And there's a bear looking up too.

Mom: Very good. 이 동물이 두더지야. 두더지는 지하에 산단다. This animal is a mole. Moles live underground.

Child: Oh ok.

Mom: Is there something different about the bear?

Child: It's all white. Its backpack is white too.

Mom: Any idea why?

Child: Well, the weather looks cold. Maybe the bear is made of snow.

Mom: Good guess. We'll find out. What is in the sky?

Child: Stars, and a shooting star.

Mom: Right. Do you think they are doing something special while looking at the sky?

Child: Maybe they're wishing on the shooting star.

Mom: Yes, good guess. What would you wish for if you saw a shooting star?

Child: I don't know... maybe a dog.

Mom: That's a big wish.

Mom: What do you see?

Child: The little mole walking in the snow.

Mom: Yes, so I guess you were right. It's the mole's footsteps. Where do you think he's going?

Child: To school.

Mom: Why do you think that?

Child: He has a backpack.

Mom: I think that's a good guess.

Mom: What do you see?

Child: The mole is walking in the snow. And he is looking at a big snowball.

Mom: What do you think Little Mole is thinking?

Child: "That's a big snowball. Who made it?"

Mom: Good idea! Do you think he's going to do something with it?

Child: I don't know, maybe.

Mom: What do you like to do in the snow?

Child: I like walking in it, kicking up the snow. I like to make snowmen.

Mom: Me, too.

Mom: What happened?

Child: Little Mole rolled the snowball into a really big one.

Mom: How big?

Child: Bigger than him. Maybe 2 times, 3 times bigger.

Mom: Wow, that's so big. Where is Little Mole?

Child: He's at a bus stop by some trees.

Mom: Where do you think he's going?

Child: Maybe school. Maybe home.

Mom: Let's see.

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: The bus came.

Mom: What does the bus look like?

Child: It's blue. It has two levels.

Mom: 응, 이건 2 층 버스라고 한단다. 타본 적 있니? Yes, that's called a double decker bus. Have you

ever been in one?

Child: No, but I've seen them. They look fun.

Mom: Yes, they are. You can see so much from the second floor. Who's on the bus?

Child: Different animals. Some rabbits and bears, I think.

Mom: 누가 버스를 운전하고 있니? Who's driving the bus?

Child: A bear.

Mom: Do you see anyone else?

Child: A fox or a wolf, and a mouse got off the bus. They are reading. The fox has glasses on.

Mom: Good. Where is this happening?

Child: It looks like a forest.

Mom: What do you think will happen now?

Child: Little Mole will get on the bus.

Mom: What happened?

Child: Little Mole didn't get on the bus. He is still waiting.

Mom: 왜 버스를 안탔을까? Why do you think he didn't get on?

Child: Maybe it was the wrong bus. Or maybe he didn't want to get on yet. He made his snowball into a big bear.

Mom: Yeah, maybe he wasn't done playing in the snow. Can you make a snow bear this big?

Child: Yeah, I can!

Mom: Is Little Mole doing anything special with the snow bear on the right page?

Child: He's holding the bear's hand.

Mom: Why do you think he's doing that?

Child: Maybe he thinks it's his friend.

Mom: Maybe.

Mom: What's happening here?

Child: There's another bus. It's green.

Mom: 이번에도 이층버스인가? Is this a double decker too?

Child: No, only one level. There are round windows.

Mom: Yes. Who's driving?

Child: A fox.

Mom: What is Little Mole doing?

Child: He looks like he's talking to the fox bus driver. He's looking back at the bear.

Mom: What do you think Little Mole is saying?

Child: "I don't want to leave my snow bear."

Mom: Good guess. Do you see anything else?

Child: A squirrel is getting off the bus from a ladder on the side?

Mom: Are you sure it's getting off?

Child: Oh wait, I see his footprints going to the bus. He's getting on.

Mom: Very good! Anything else?

Child: A deer and her kid got off the bus. The little deer is eating a lollipop.

Mom: Cute!

Mom: What's happening here?

Child: Little Mole changed the snow bear.

Mom: How?

Child: He made it smaller and gave it a backpack.

Mom: Why do you think he did that?

Child: To make it look more like his friend, who's waiting with him for the bus. I think he's a little lonely waiting by himself, so he wants someone with him.

Mom: I think you're right.

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: It's night. And Little Mole sees a shooting star.

Mom: Do you think little mole is wishing for something?

Child: Yes. I think he's wishing his snow bear was real.

Mom: I think that could be right. So where do you think Little Mole is going?

Child: I think he's going home, because it's late.

Mom: Yes, I think that's correct. What will happen to the snow bear when Little Mole gets on the bus?

Child: I guess he has to stay behind.

Mom: Do you think Little Mole will be sad?

Child: Yes.

Mom: What is happening on the left page?

Child: Little Mole gave Snow Bear his hat.

Mom: What do you think about this?

Child: It's funny, because he wants to give it to Snow Bear because he thinks he's cold, but Bear is made of snow, so he's always cold.

Mom: 맞아, 모자가 도움이 됐을까? Right, so do you think the hat helps?

Child: No, not really.

Mom: What does this show about Little Mole?

Child: That he's really nice, and he thinks Snow Bear is his friend.

Mom: Yes, Little Mole is really caring. What about the right page?

Child: Snow Bear is looking at the sky.

Mom: 두더지의 소원이 이루어졌다고 생각하니? 눈으로 만든 곰이 진짜일까? Do you think Little

Mole's wish came true? That Snow Bear is real now?

Child: Maybe.

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: Another bus came.

Mom: Who's driving this time?

Child: A deer.

Mom: What is Little Mole doing?

Child: He's waving his hand and holding Snow Bear's hand.

Mom: Why do you think he's doing that?

Child: He wants Snow Bear to get on the bus with him.

Mom: Do you think it will happen this time?

Child: Maybe. Snow Bear looks real with the hat and backpack.

Mom: Let's find out.

Mom: What happened?

Child: Little Mole and Snow Bear got on the bus!

Mom: Wow, how do you think that happened?

Child: I guess Little Mole's wish came true.

Mom: Maybe. How does Little Mole look?

Child: Sleepy. He closed his eyes.

Mom: And Snow Bear?

Child: He's just sitting on the bus seat.

Mom: 다른 승객들이 있니? Are there other passengers?

Child: Yes, lots! I see a big bear with a Christmas tree. I see two mice eating honey from a jar. I see a rabbit holding carrots, and her kid is sitting on the belly of another big animal. I don't know what animal that is.

Mom: 응, 말하기가 좀 어렵긴 해. 멧돼지 같기도 하고. 코와 상아가 보이니? Yes, it's a little hard to tell. I think it's a wild pig. See its nose and tusks?

Child: Oh yes, it looks like a pig's nose.

Mom: Do you see anyone else?

Child: Yes, a deer is reading. And a cat is knitting next to Snow Bear.

Mom: Do the other animals seem to know that Snow Bear isn't real?

Child: No, they seem to just be riding the bus.

Mom: What can you see here?

Child: Little Mole fell asleep then woke up. He went to the front of the bus.

Mom: Why?

Child: I think he's asking the deer bus driver something.

Mom: What do you think he's asking?

Child: "Where's Bear?"

Mom: Oh, is Bear gone?

Child: Yes. Only the hat Little Mole gave him is left.

Mom: What do you think happened to him?

Child: He melted while Little Mole was asleep.

Mom: I think you're right. How do you think Little Mole feels?

Child: Sad.

Mom: What do you think the deer is saying?

Child: "Sorry, I don't know where Bear went."

Mom: Yes, maybe.

Mom: What is happening?

Child: Little Mole got off the bus and is walking in the snow.

Mom: How do you think he feels?

Child: Sad and lonely.

Mom: 두더지가 또 다른 눈 곰을 만들 것 같니? Do you think he will make another snow bear?

Child: I don't know, maybe.

Mom: What do you see?

Child: Little Mole finally got home.

Mom: Is anyone else there?

Child: Yes, his mom or grandma.

Mom: Why do you think it's his grandma?

Child: Because of the glasses, it makes her look a little old.

Mom: Yes. What are they doing?

Child: The grandma is hugging Little Mole.

Mom: What do you think Little Mole is saying?

Child: "I made a snow bear, but he's gone."

Mom: What do you think Grandma will do?

Child: I don't know. Maybe she will make him hot cocoa.

Mom: That's a good idea.

Mom: What's happening here?

Child: Little Mole is in bed.

Mom: Is he sleeping?

Child: No.

Mom: Why not?

Child: I think he's missing snow bear.

Mom: I think you're right. Maybe he can make a new friend.

Child: Yes.

Mom: So what happened?

Child: It looks like Little Mole remembered something or heard something and he got out of bed.

Mom: Where is he going?

Child: I don't know, up outside. He put on his hat and gloves.

Mom: Yes, moles live underground so they need to go up a tunnel to get outside.

Child: Yes, a tunnel, that's what this looks like.

Mom: What do you think he heard?

Child: I don't know. Maybe someone knocking.

Mom: Who do you think it is?

Child: Maybe a friend.

Mom: What happened?

Child: It's Snow Bear!

Mom: Wow, where did he come from?

Child: There are some footprints going close to the bear. I think Grandma made him.

Mom: I think you're right. Why did she make him?

Child: Because Little Mole was missing his friend and was lonely and sad. She wanted to make his wish

come true.

Mom: How do you think Little Mole feels?

Child: He's happy. He's running to Snow Bear.

Mom: What do you think about Grandma?

Child: She really loves Little Mole.

Mom: Yes. What do you think about your grandma?

Child: She's really nice. I really love her. She loves me too.

Mom: How do you know?

Child: She gives me lots of hugs and always makes my favorite snack.

Mom: Right!

Mom: What do you see on the last pages?

Child: Two kinds of footprints in the snow.

Mom: Where are they going?

Child: I don't know, but they are going the same way.

Mom: Do they belong to different people or the same?

Child: Different. They are different sizes. One is bigger than the other.

Mom: Whose do you think they are?

Child: Little Mole and Grandma. Or maybe Little Mole and Snow Bear.

Mom: Yes, good guesses. Do you remember the first pages? How are these pages different?

Child: On the first pages, there was only one set. It's the smaller one. It's Little Mole.

Mom: What do you think the difference between the beginning and the end means?

Child: Little Mole was by himself, and now he's not anymore.

Mom: Excellent!

4. Activity

1) Read Aloud
