1. Background Knowledge

Mom: 태어날 때 기억이 나니? Do you remember being born?

Child: No.

Mom: 엄마도 기억 안나. 제일 처음 기억나는 게 뭐야? Me neither. What is the earliest thing you remember?

Child: I remember going to the park with you.

Mom: Do you know how old you were?

Child: I think I was 3 or 4.

Mom: 이 책에서는 지금은 크지만 작게 시작했던 다양한 생명에 대해 이야기하고 있어. This book tries to talk about something that is really big but that can also be small. It might be a little hard to understand.

Child: What's that?

Mom: Let's see together.

2. Picture Walking

[Cover Page]

Mom: Look at the cover. There's a moon in the middle, in the sky, with some stars around it. And there are lots of leaves and branches around the moon. We can see the moon through the branches.

Child: And there are some birds in the branches.

Mom: Can you see any other animals?

Child: I see a snake and a gorilla.

Mom: Good. Anything else?

Child: There's water at the bottom.

Mom: Good. So we can see some living things hiding in the branches.

Child: Yes!

Mom: Do you think there are any living things in the water too?

Child: Yes, I do.

[page 1-2]

Mom: There's a lake with mountains all around. And there's something swimming in the lake. What does it look like?

Child: It has big eyes and a tail.

Mom: What do you think it is?

Child: It kind of looks like a lizard or a salamander. Maybe it's a frog growing from a tadpole.

Mom: 아, 그럼 올챙이와 개구리의 중간을 말하는 거니? Oh, so you mean in the middle between a tadpole and a frog?

Child: Yes, right!

Mom: That's a really good guess. Do you see anything else in the water?

Child: There are some things that look like bugs, and I think a jellyfish.

Mom: Very good!

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: There's an elephant trunk.

Mom: Good eye!

Child: There are a couple of elephant footprints and rocks.

Mom: (오른쪽 페이지를 짚으며) There is a little plant growing in the middle of some sand I think, and there are mountains all around.

Mom: Why do you think it's all alone?

Child: Maybe there's not enough water for more plants.

Mom: That's a good idea.

[page 5-6]

Mom: There are lots of big elephants in the sand, and one small baby elephant in the middle.

살아있는 것들이 많아졌어. 아기 코끼리 귀엽지 않니? Wow, suddenly there are lots of living things.

Are you surprised by how small the baby is compared to the big elephants?

Child: Yes, it's really small next to the big ones.

Mom: 모든 것들은 작은 것부터 시작된단다. 너도 마찬가지야. All life starts small. Even you.

Child: Right.

[page 7-8]

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: I see the mommy elephant and the baby elephant walking.

Mom: Where are they walking?

Child: In the desert.

Mom: 사막인걸 어떻게 알았니? How do you know it's the desert?

Child: There's a big hot sun, and there aren't any trees. The ground is orange and red. It looks too

hot.

Mom: Very good. (오른쪽 페이지를 짚으며) What about this picture?

Child: It's night, and they're under a big moon. Here there are more trees, so maybe it's cooler.

Mom: Very good.

[page 9-10]

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: Lots of animals!

Mom: Do you know what some of them are?

Child: There's a whale. A camel, a monkey, a polar bear, a giraffe...

Mom: Right, there are so many.

Mom: 이 세상에 다양한 종류의 동물들이 있다는 게 신기하지 않니? Isn't it amazing there are so many different kinds of animals in the world?

Child: Yes!

[page 11-12]

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: I see a big bird flying over some snowy mountains.

Mom: 어떤 새인지 알겠니? Right, can you tell what kind of bird it is?

Child: Maybe a hawk or an eagle.

Mom: Good guesses. (낙타를 짚으며) And it's a camel in the sand.

Can you guess what the hawk and the camel would like?

Child: I think the hawk likes flying and the camel likes the sand.

Mom: I think you're right.

Mom: What's happening here?

Child: There's a snake in some long grass.

Mom: 뱀에 대해서 알고 있는 게 있니? Can you tell more about the snake?

Child: It's long and green.

Mom: Right. What does this snake like?

Child: Maybe, it likes grass.

Mom: You're right.

[page 15-16]

Mom: There's a big turtle on a rock in the water.

What's the weather like?

Child: It's raining.

Mom: A little?

Child: A lot!

Mom: 거북이가 비를 맞는 걸 걱정하는 것 같니? Does the turtle look worried?

Child: No, it looks comfortable.

Mom: I guess this turtle likes heavy rain.

Child: Yes.

[page 17-18]

Mom: What is happening?

There's a bird flying by itself in the middle of a big storm.

How do you think the bird feels?

Child: Scared, cold?

Mom: Do you think it will be ok?

Child: I don't know, maybe if it can fly fast.

Mom: Let's find out.

[page 19-20]

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: Oh, the storm is over.

Mom: Well, that's a relief. Where's the bird now?

Child: It's flying over some high mountains.

Mom: I think it's hard because there's no place to rest and no friends.

Child: Maybe.

[page 21-22]

Mom: The bird is still flying.

And there are some dark trees and branches. And some animals hiding behind them.

재들이 새의 친구가 될 수 있을 것 같니? Do they look like they could be the bird's friends?

Child: No. The bird looks scared. It should be careful.

Mom: What should the bird do?

Child: Fly away as fast as it can.

Mom: Wow, it must be tired.

Child: Yes.

Mom: A really nice place, with lots of sun and water and lots of different animals.

이 곳은 새에게 좋은 장소일까? Does this look like a nice place for the bird?

Child: Yes.

Mom: Can you see the bird?

Child: Yes, it's there, flying.

Mom: Maybe the bird will soon find a good place to rest.

Child: Yes.

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: A dog with a stick in its mouth, under some trees!

Mom: What about on the other page?

Child: A cat looking at me through a window.

Mom: Where's the cat?

Child: It's in a house.

Mom: How are the dog and cat alike and different from the ones we saw in the book before this?

Child: The dog and cat can be pets.

Mom: 맞아, 강아지와 고양이는 사람과 함께 살 수 있단다. Right, they can live with people.

And all the other animals in the book are not like the dog and cat. How?

Child: They are wild.

Mom: Where do they have to live?

Child: In the wild, the forest, the desert.

Mom: Right, in nature.

Mom: (고릴라와 북극곰을 짝지어) A gorilla in the woods. And a polar bear!

What do gorilla and polar bears have in common?

Child: They are big.

Mom: Right. And they are endangered animals. We have to protect them.

Mom: Where is this?

Child: It's really dark. Maybe the forest at night?

Mom: It could be. What is at the top of the page?

Child: They look like swimming fish.

Mom: Right! So maybe this is...?

Child: In the deep ocean.

Mom: Very good! Deep in the ocean, is there any light?

Child: No.

Mom: So it can look black like night.

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: A rabbit with big ears.

Mom: And?

Child: A deer.

Mom: And?

Child: A white wolf in the mountains.

Mom: And?

Child: Some white birds flying over water.

Mom: Very good! These are geese.

Mom: What's happening?

Child: Lots of birds are flying into the sky from a tree.

[page 35-36]

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: Big whales in the water!

Mom: What are they doing?

Child: Swimming.

Mom: What about their eyes?

Child: They're closed.

Mom: So what does this look like?

Child: It looks like they're sleeping or waking up.

Mom: Why do you say that?

Child: It looks like they're going up towards the top of the water and the sun.

Mom: Yes, it does look like that. Very good! Are there any other animals?

Child: There's one little seal.

Mom: Right!

Mom: What do you see?

Child: A big elephant foot.

Mom: 정말 크다! It's really big, isn't it?

Child: Yeah!

Mom: Do you think it's alone?

Child: I think there are other elephants around.

Mom: Where are we now?

Child: Back in the nice land, with all the animals.

Mom: Is there anything different about this picture?

Child: Lots of the animals are in groups.

Mom: Very good. What animals can you see?

Child: Monkeys, elephants, zebras maybe, a giraffe and a leopard. Oh, and a lion.

Mom: Very good. I guess the elephant found its friends.

Mom: What's on these last pages?

Child: It's the land at night.

Mom: What can you see?

Child: Some monkeys sleeping in the trees

Mom: That's nice. Anything else?

Child: The big moon. And the leopard walking down the hill.

Mom: Right! How does this picture make you feel?

Child: Calm and relaxed. Sleepy.

Mom: Yes. It looks peaceful.
