1. Background Knowledge

2. Picture Walking

[Cover page]

Mom: Look at the cover. What do you see?

Child: I see two penguins, a grown-up penguin and a little penguin.

Mom: What are they doing?

Child: They're hugging each other.

Mom: You're right. Let's go on.

[Title page]

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: I think the three penguins are families.

Mom: How?

Child: They must be father penguin, mother penguin, and baby penguin.

Mom: That's a good guess. Turn the page.

Mom: Wow, I see a huge iceberg floating on an arctic ocean.

Child: I see it, too.

Mom: What else can you see?

Child: I also see a lot of penguins. They are lined up in the cliff of iceberg.

Mom: Good. I think these penguins are waiting to jump into the water.

Why do you think they are jumping into the sea?

Child: They want to catch a fish.

Mom: Good answer. Do you also see some seals on the left?

Child: Yes, I see them too! I think they're families also.

Mom: What is Mummy Penguin doing?

Child: She's sliding down the iceberg.

Mom: Why?

Child: I don't know, maybe to catch a fish.

Mom: So why did Mummy Penguin slide down the iceberg?

Child: She was trying to get dinner for Daddy Penguin and Little Penguin.

Mom: Good! Do you think she'll succeed?

Child: She has to, or else the family will starve.

Mom: What's happening?

Child: Daddy Penguin is pointing at Mummy Penguin!

Mom: Did the family see Mummy Penguin?

Child: Yes! Mummy Penguin waved at them!

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: Mummy Penguin, along with other penguins, is trying to catch fish.

Mom: Good eye. They are swimming in the sea to catch fish.

Can you count how many penguins are in the sea?

Child: Six, including Mummy Penguin.

Mom: Right. I hope Mummy succeeds.

Mom: Did Mummy Penguin catch fish?

Child: Yes, she did! She got it!

Mom: Good for her and the penguin family.

[page 10]

Mom: What are Little Penguin and Daddy Penguin talking about?

Child: Little Penguin is asking if Mummy Penguin will come back.

I think Little Penguin misses his mom.

Mom: I think so too. Poor Little Penguin.

[page 11-12]

Mom: What's happening here?

Child: The penguins are coming back to iceberg.

Mom: Yes, and look how high they can leap!

Where is Mummy Penguin?

Child: It looks like she's still in the water.

[page 13]

Mom: Did Mummy Penguin come back to iceberg?

Child: Yes, she did. She made it.

[page 14]

Mom: What are Little Penguin and Daddy Penguin talking about?

Child: Little Penguin is asking if Mummy Penguin will come back soon.

Mom: Poor Little Penguin. I hope Mummy Penguin comes back soon.

Mom: What's going on now?

Child: The penguins are climbing up the icy cliff.

Mom: Very nice. What about Mummy Penguin?

Child: She's the last one to climb.

The icy cliff must be very slippery.

Mom: Did Mummy Penguin climb the icy cliff?

Child: Yes, she did. She did it.

[page 18]

Mom: What are Little Penguin and Daddy Penguin talking about?

Child: Little Penguin is asking if Mummy Penguin will be here very soon.

Mom: Poor Little Penguin. I hope Mummy Penguin were here right now.

Mom: What are those enormous blue creatures?

Child: They are seals.

Mom: What's the problem?

Child: Mummy Penguins must sneak past the sleeping seals without making any noise!

Mom: Very good. What would happen if the seals wake up?

Child: Mummy Penguins, along with other penguins, won't be safe.

Mom: You're right. Be careful, Mummy Penguin!

Mom: Oh, no! What happened?

Child: A seal is awake!

Mom: Do you think Mummy Penguin is in trouble?

Child: Yes, possibly.

Mom: Uh-oh. Mummy Penguin is falling off the cliff, because a seal woke up suddenly.

Child: Mummy Penguin is falling down the cliff and off the edge of iceberg.

Mom: Right. Where does she end up?

Child: Way back in the sea.

Mom: How do Little Penguin and Daddy Penguin look?

Child: They both look so worried and surprised.

Mom: Yes. Little Penguin's eyes are very big.

Let's turn the page to see what happens next!

Mom: Hooray! Mummy Penguin is coming back.

Child: She's leaping onto the ice. She's good at swimming.

Mom: Good for Mummy Penguin.

Mom: Now, what's happening?

Child: Mummy Penguin jumps over the seals. She's so brave.

Mom: Yes, and the seals look so confused!

Do you think Mummy Penguin will come back home soon?

Child: Yes, she will. She has to! The family is waiting for her.

Mom: So did Mummy Penguin eventually come back?

Child: Yes, she did!

Mom: Right.

Child: Mummy Penguin is very happy to finally see Little Penguin. So is Little Penguin.

Mom: What about Daddy Penguin?

Child: Daddy Penguin is relieved to see Mummy Penguin, too.

Child: It's a fish! She came back with dinner for her little one.

Child: He told her that she's the best!
