Mom: Let's read this book together and find out why.

2. Picture Walking

[Cover Page]

Mom: Look at the cover. What do you see?

Child: I see some children on the roof of the buildings.

Mom: Anything else? What are they looking at?

Child: Paper planes!

Mom: Yes, these are paper planes. And also some birds, do you see them?

Child: Yes. Two green birds and one brown or yellow bird are flying in the air.

Mom: Good. Let's see more.

Mom: Many children are sitting on the ground in the woods.

What do you think they are doing? Why?

Child: I think they are having a picnic. They are eating something, sitting on a blanket.

Mom: That is a great guess. What are children eating or drinking?

Child: They are eating cookies, pieces of bread, apple, and drinking from a cup of water.

Mom: Good eye. Do they look the same or different?

Child: Different! They are wearing different clothes. Hair styles and skin color are different.

Mom: You're right. They look quite different from each other but it looks like they're having a good time, don't they?

Child: Yes. They look happy and bright.

Mom: Here you see a herd of sheep, can you count them?

Child: 12 sheep.

Mom: Good. Also the bird and clouds in the sky, how many are there?

Child: One bird and two clouds.

Mom: Great job. What is the boy in the middle wearing?

Child: He's wearing a blue gown, a pair of black boots, a muffler, and a hat.

Mom: What do you think he's doing?

Child: Maybe he's watching the sheep with his dog.

Mom: Right. Can you guess which part of the world he's from?

Child: Hmm... I'm not so sure.

Mom: It's not an easy question. Let's see more.

Mom: What is happening in this page?

Child: A girl is on the bird.

Mom: Do you know what kind of bird this is?

Child: A magpie?

Mom: Good! So three magpies are flying in the air, and the girl is riding the biggest one.

Do you see a tall tower at the bottom right?

Child: Yes.

Mom: That is Eiffel Tower. Eiffel Tower is a famous tower in France.

So can you tell me what country this is?

Child: France?

Mom: You're right!

Mom: I see a boy in the bottom left. And, an animal is coming towards the boy.

What animal is that?

Child: A bear!

Mom: Yes. What do you think the bear and the boy is doing?

Child: It looks like the boy is giving some food to the bear.

Mom: Right! Do you think the weather is cold or hot in this picture?

Child: It looks cold.

Mom: Why is that?

Child: There are some snow on the ground, trees, and on even on the roof of the house.

Mom: What is happening here?

Child: A big elephant is lifting a girl with its trunk.

The girl is giving a feather to the bird. The bird is resting on the nest.

Mom: What else do you see?

Child: I see a lot of trees, another flying bird, and a building that looks like castle.

Mom: Good for you. Would you want to ride on elephant's trunk, like this girl?

Child: Yes, it looks fun.

Mom: A small boy is holding a gray object. This is called watering can.

You use it to give water to plants, especially flowers and trees.

Child: The watering can looks heavy for the boy. It's big.

Mom: I think so too. What is he watering?

Child: Pink and purple flowers.

Mom: What are those things flying over the flowers?

Child: They are insects. These are bees, ladybugs, and a butterfly.

Mom: Yes. Very good! And can you count the flowers for me?

Child: One, two, three... six flowers!

Mom: What's happening here?

Child: Children everywhere!

Mom: Where are they? What are they doing?

Child: One is looking out through the window. Others are outside at the tree house.

Mom: You're right. Anything else? Tell me what they are doing.

Child: Well, two girls are beside the tree. One girl is sitting on top of the tree house and the other is hanging on the tree branch. A boy is climbing the ladder.

Mom: Good eye. It looks like children are having a fun time together, huh?

Child: I guess so.

Mom: Do you think these children look alike each other?

Child: Not exactly. They are different in skin colors and clothes.

Mom: Yes. But they seem to get along well.

Mom: A girl is playing with toy trucks. How many trucks do you see?

Child: Seven trucks.

Mom: Yes. What's that on the trucks?

Child: It's the sand.

Mom: What is happening here?

Child: Eight bumblebees are playing some instruments.

Mom: What kind of instruments?

Child: Guitar, violin, trumpet and accordion.

Mom: Good job. Anything else?

Child: A boy is watching the whole thing!

Mom: Right. The boy is watching bumblebees playing musical instruments! Looks fun, right?

Child: Yes.

Mom: And what are those green plants in the background?

Child: They are called cactuses.

Mom: Do you see a girl and a boy here?

Child: Yes. A boy is giving a girl something made of flowers.

Mom: That's right. He's putting on a flower wreath on the girl's head.

What color is the girl's hair?

Child: It's orange.

Mom: And the boy's T-shirt?

Child: It's sky blue and navy. It's a striped T-shirt.

Mom: Very good. How do you think they are right now? Do they look happy, or sad?

Child: They look very happy!

Mom: I see so many things happening here!

First, a man is sitting on a carpet. Maybe it's a flying magic carpet.

Another man is on the boat!

Can you tell me more?

Child: I see a bicycle, a fish, an airplane, an elephant.

Mom: And?

Child: A monkey and school bus. A snail. A tiger on two wheels.

Mom: Good. Do you see a white shadow in the background, that looks like a some kind of building?

Child: Yes, I see it.

Mom: You see these kinds of buildings in India.

Child: So the country here is India?

Mom: Right.

Mom: How many children are in this picture?

Child: Ten children.

Mom: Are there any animals?

Child: There's a bird, a donkey, two mice and a cat.

Mom: What are children doing on the left page?

Child: Some kids are sitting on the stairs.

A girl is letting the bird go.

A boy is waving at something. And there's also a donkey!

Mom: Great job! How about on the right page?

Child: A boy is playing with soccer ball.

A girl is looking outside in the balcony!

There's a girl and a cat, too.

Mom: Nice. I can also see two little mice over the number 2.

Mom: What is the girl doing?

Child: Riding skateboard, showing some moves.

Mom: Is anybody watching her?

Child: Yes. Nine children are watching her.

Mom: Do you see anybody else?

Child: Oh, yes! One boy is looking out the window.

Mom: A girl and a boy is playing soccer in the woods.

Child: I can also see a bird on a fence!

And a squirrel is reading a book in the tree!

Mom: Good eye! How many fences are there?

Child: Nine.

Mom: What about the kid? What do you think he's doing?

Child: He's going inside the house. I think he just finished playing jump rope.

Child: It's trying to get inside the giant shoe! Ouch!

Mom: That's right. And do these children look the same or different? What do you think?

Child: I think they all look different but they seem happy together!

Mom: Good. We've almost reached the end. Let's see more.

Mom: How do you feel when I give you a good night kiss?

Child: They are sleeping in their beds. It's night.

Mom: Good! What about their parents?

Child: They are standing near the door, watching the children sleeping.

Child: It would be the kite and board game.

What are those on the tree?

Child: It's a family of birds.

Mom: What are the birds doing?

Child: They're sleeping. It's night because the moon and stars are out.

Child: Yes. I really like it.

Mom: The mother bird is also caring its babies because it loves them.
