1. Background Knowledge

2. Picture Walking

[Cover page]

Mom: Look at the cover. What's happening?

Child: Two penguins are looking at each other.

Mom: Look at their beaks. What color is it?

Child: The left one is yellow, blue and orange

The right one is yellow, blue and red.

Mom: Good. Let's read the book and see what's it tells us.

[page 1]

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: A little penguin.

Mom: You're right. I guess his name is Steve.

[page 2]

Mom: What's happening?

Child: Another penguin appeared.

Mom: He looks just like Steve, doesn't he?

Child: Yes, but he tells that he is also Steve.

Mom: Right. Let's go on.

[page 3]

Mom: It seems like an argument is starting.

Child: They are telling each other that he/she was here first.

Mom: What do you think about this situation?

Child: Hilarious.

Mom: The first penguin is on a tall tower.

Child: The other penguin is carrying a ladder.

Mom: What do you think they're doing?

Child: They are claiming that they are the real Steve.

Mom: Good job.

Mom: Uh-oh. It looks like the second penguin is pushing the first one off the tower.

Child: The first one dropped his medal!

Mom: You're right.

Child: The second one is also asking for the first one's birthday!

Mom: Do you think they're starting a fight?

Child: Maybe.

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: Some balloons. It looks like a party.

Mom: The second penguin is making fun of the first one.

He is saying that he's older than the first one.

Child: The first penguin looks angry.

Mom: What's happening?

Child: The second penguin is arguing that he's wiser and taller.

Mom: Do you think that's true? What the second penguin says?

Child: Maybe, but I think the two penguins are much similar.

Mom: I think so too.

Mom: The two Steves are in the deep blue sea.

Child: They are swimming in the sea.

Mom: What are they competing about?

Child: They are competing on how many fish they can catch.

Mom: Turn the page to see the result.

Mom: So who's the winner?

Child: The second penguin. He caught way more fish.

Mom: So is he the real Steve?

Child: I'm not so sure, not yet.

Mom: Now what's happening?

Child: The second penguin is arguing that he's fast and strong!

Mom: Right. What's he doing to prove it?

Child: He's riding a skateboard.

He's also lifting up an elephant!

Mom: The first penguin is now reacting! How does he react?

Child: The first penguin is saying, "You've got weird feet." to the second penguin.

Mom: How does the second penguin look?

Child: He looks so embarrassed!

Mom: Do you think it's good to make fun of a friend like that?

Child: I don't think it's a good idea.

Mom: Now, what are the two Steves doing?

Child: They're having a fight.

Mom: How?

Child: They're calling each other names.

Mom: Did the two Steves make up?

Child: Not yet.

Mom: Do you think they will, eventually?

Child: Yes, eventually.

Mom: What do you see here?

Child: They finally said sorry to each other.

Mom: Yes, it looks like they have finally stopped fighting. What else?

Child: They finally called each other 'Steve.'

Mom: Good eye! They finally recognized each other.

Child: They are sharing the bowling ball.

Mom: Right. What do you think they'll do?

Child: They are getting ready to play bowling.

Child: I think the end is quite hilarious.
