2. Picture Walking

[Cover page]
Mom: Look at the cover. What do you see?
Child: I see some underwater creatures.
Mom: What are they?
Child: I see a crab, a shell, some fish, and a starfish.
Mom: Good. Let's read the book and find out where Swimmy's friends are.

[page 1-2]
Mom: Where can Swimmy be?
Child: I don't know.
Mom: Lift the flap to find out.
Child: There he is!
Mom: Where is he?
Child: He's behind the giant shell.

[page 3-4]
Mom: Where are Swimmy's brothers and sisters?
Child: I don't know.
Mom: Lift the flap to find out.
Child: There they are?
Mom: Where are they?
Child: They're behind a big rock.

[page 5-6]
Mom: Now, let's meet Swimmy's friends.
Child: Where are they?
Mom: Some are behind these rocks. Do you see the rocks?
Child: Yes, I see them.
Mom: Lift the flap to find out who Swimmy's friends are. Who are they?

Child: Lobsters!

[page 7-8]Mom: Other friends are hiding behind the seaweed.Child: Where?Mom: Behind the seaweed. Lift the flap to find out who they are!Child: They are eels! The eels are behind the seaweed.Mom: Very good.

[page 9-10]

Mom: Swimmy also has some graceful friends. Can you guess who they are?Child: Hmm... I don't think so.Mom: Lift the flap to find out.Child: Some graceful friends are jellyfish.

[page 11-12]Mom: What is going on here?Child: Someone is swimming up behind Swimmy.Mom: Who is it? If you lift the flap, you'll see.Child: A hungry tuna.

[page 13-14]Mom: Where's Swimmy?Child: He's hiding away from the hungry tuna.Mom: So where's he hiding? Lift the flap to find out.Child: Swimmy's behind the seaweed.

[page 15-16]

Mom: Swimmy is planning to ask his friends to chase away the hungry tuna. If you lift the flap, you'll see where his friends are.
Child: His friends are gathered behind the rock.
Mom: Can you count how many?
Child: Fifteen of them.
Mom: Do you think they can chase away the tuna?
Child: I think so, yes.

[page 17-18] Mom: What is going on here? Child: Swimmy' friends, little red fish, are swimming together.

Mom: Why are they swimming together? Lift the flap. What do they look like?

Child: They look like a giant fish in a whole!

Mom: Very good. Look at them. There are tens of red fish swimming together.

So did they succeed in scaring away the tuna?

Child: Yes. The hungry tuna is now running away.

Mom: You're right. Swimmy and his friends worked together to look a lot bigger than the tuna.
